Please read the below for information regards Monday 17th July.

If your son/daughter is attending Alton Towers can you please ensure you are at school on Monday by 7.30am. The weather can be very changeable therefore please ensure that they have appropriate clothing for wet weather but also for protection from the sun. i.e. suncream and a hat. They should have enough money to purchase food and drinks to remain hydrated throughout the day. Pupils who receive free school meals will have a packed lunch provided which they can collect from Frog Fountain. Pupils will be arriving back at school at approximately 6pm. Therefore please arrange for the necessary collection/travel arrangements with your son/daughter.

If your son/daughter has chosen to take part in the "In School" Alternative reward trip then school starts at the normal time of 8.25am. We are asking that pupils come to school in their PE kit with their blazer. Footwear should be PE acceptable trainers, Therefore no casual sport shoes like Converse etc. School will finish at the normal time of 3pm.

If your son/daughter is not on either of the reward trips then the school day will run as normal with a start of 8.25am but with an adapted timetable. Pupils will be expected to attend school on this day. They must be dressed in full school uniform as normal but can they also bring in their PE kit regardless of whether they have PE on a Monday normally.
