Dear Parents/Carers,

I am writing to inform you that we have been successful in securing funding to replace our existing bike shelter. Due to the timeframe involved in the installation of the new shelter, work will commence tomorrow, **Wednesday 19th October**, and will be completed ready for pupils to return to school after the half term holiday.

Once work commences tomorrow there will be no access to the existing bike shelter via the footpath from Guilford Road. There will be a small number of bike stands relocated by the side of the sports hall. If pupils need to lock up their bikes, they will access the bike stands by entering the pedestrian gate at the right-hand side of the main school entrance. Please ensure pupils walk their bikes down the footpath for their own safety, as this area is also used as a car park. The double gates at the bottom of the path will be open for pupils to securely park their bikes.

There will be no access to school for pupils entering via Guilford Road from Wednesday 19th October to Friday 21st October, they must enter via the main entrance on New Lane for health and safety reasons.

There will be a limited number of bike stands available so if it is not essential for your child to travel by bike **from Wednesday 19th October**, can I please ask that they use an alternative form of transport.
