



Remote Learning Arrangements

Dear Parents/Carers,

All students in Years 7-11 have been told to do remote learning until the February Half Term, except for those children classed as vulnerable or children of keyworkers. These are the remote learning arrangements every child should follow.

- 1. Visit http://www.stpatricksrchigh.co.uk and click on the RM Unify link at the top of the page
- 2. Students will then log in with their school email address and password. An example of the email address is <u>j.bloggs@stpatricksrchigh.co.uk</u>
- 3. Once they've logged in they will scroll down to Microsoft Teams and again log in with their school email address and password
- 4. Click on the **calendar** in Teams then click on **Form** for that day and **Join** the meeting at **8.30am every day** in order to register their attendance for the day.
- 5. From there Students will then follow their usual timetable for the rest of the day. Work will be set by teachers on Google Classroom, Students may also have some live lessons/recorded lessons or catch ups with teachers, all information can be found on Google Classroom.

- 7. Your child can contact their form tutors and class teachers via Gmail or through Google Classroom if needed.
