



# Year 7 Summer Reads by Miss Tandy

Omri is disappointed with his birthday present – a little red plastic Indian figure – until it comes alive and becomes a real person.




## **'The Secret Diary or Adrian Mole Aged 13 3/4' By Sue Townsend**

The horrors of the blitz are told through the eyes of a cat, who is searching for her lost owner. Delightful read.




## **'Holes' by Louis Sachar**

## **'The Book Thief' by Marcus Zusak**


Narrated by Death, this book tells the story of a young girl in Nazi Germany hiding for safety in World War 2. A world wide success!



## **'The Village Sang To The Sea' by Bruce McAllister**


When he and his parents moved to a small fishing village in Italy, Brad Lattimer finds himself in a world of strangeness. Superb!




## **'Ways to live Forever'** by Sally Nicholls
