Many people claim to have had near death experiences which cannot be explained by human logic or science. Their accounts often contain similar elements: a bright light, separation from their physical body, feelings of calm and peace, despite knowing they are dead, being in a garden interacting with dead friends and relatives

Muslims believe that life after death (Akhirah) exists. They believe that heaven and hell exist and we will all be judged by God. Barzakh is the state between this life and the next. Angels will ask 3 questions about our faith during this time.



Following the mistake made by Adam and Eve, which led to evil entering the world, God offered **salvation**. This means human souls can be saved from eternal punishment (or separation from God) and are allowed to enter Heaven (and be in the presence of God).



Reincarnation is the movement of the soul (atman) into another body to begin a new life. Hindus believe that the new body we take on will be determined by the Karma from our previous life.

Karma, or 'action' (in the **Sanskrit** language), means that all actions have consequences. For example, seeds that are planted now will grow into plants in the future, and actions in the present will have positive or negative outcomes in the future. Negative consequences created through negative actions can have effects in this life or future lives.
