The infinitive is the form of the verb you find in the dictionary or word list. It often translates as 'to do something'.

escuchar v to listen

In Spanish, all infinitives end in **-ar**, **-er** or **-ir**. How many of each group can you find in exercise 1?

When **me gusta** is followed by another verb, that verb must be in the infinitive.

Me gusta **escuchar** música.
I like **to listen/listening** to music.

The PRESENT tense of AR verbs

1. Take the INFINITIVE
2. Remove the last two letters to make a STEM
3. Add the appropriate ending

Tú	You	as
Él / Ella	He / She	a
Nosotros	We	amos
Vosotros	You (pl)	áis
Ellos / Ellas	They	an

Regular INFINITIVE verbs

- BAILAR - to dance
- MONTAR - to ride
- SACAR - to take/take out
- HABLAR - to speak
- TOCAR - to play (instrument)
- CANTAR - to sing
