We are delighted to share with you our **St Patrick's Way Programme**, a unique opportunity for pupils at St Patrick's RC High School to be recognised and rewarded for their personal development, service, and commitment to our school community.

What is the St Patrick's Way Programme?

The programme is designed to help pupils grow as individuals — developing confidence, leadership, and resilience while living out our Catholic values of **Truth**, **Love**, **Faith**, **Service and Resilience**. It encourages every young person to take part in activities that strengthen their sense of belonging, kindness, and purpose both inside and outside the classroom.

Pupils complete a series of achievable challenges organised under three areas:

- Essentials Encouraging good attendance, effort and engagement in learning.
- **Contribute** Taking part in clubs, worship, and community activities.
- **Serve** Demonstrating leadership, volunteering, and helping others.

As pupils complete each stage, they can achieve **Bronze**, **Silver**, **and Gold Awards**, with the prestigious **'Best of All' Award** for those who complete every element of the programme.

For Years 7–10, pupils will take part in *The St Patrick's Way* — focusing on growth, service and community.
