### **Year 8: Castlerigg Residential Retreat**

Dear Parent/Carer,

We are excited to share details of the upcoming Year 8 Retreat to Castlerigg Manor in the Lake District. This retreat is a wonderful opportunity for our students to grow spiritually, reflect on their faith, and engage in activities that promote personal development and a sense of community. Below, we've outlined the key details of the trip, including its aims and purpose.

#### Location:

Castlerigg Manor is situated in the stunning Lake District, near the town of Keswick. Set amidst picturesque views of the surrounding mountains and lakes, the retreat centre offers an ideal environment for spiritual reflection, relaxation, and connection with nature. The peaceful and scenic setting fosters an atmosphere that encourages quiet contemplation and group bonding.

## Aims and Purpose of the Retreat:

Due to the popular demand last year, we have booked two residential retreat dates to ensure as many pupils as possible can attend. There is a maximum of 60 places available for each retreat. The residential retreats will take place on the following dates: Group 1: Monday 15<sup>th</sup> December - Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> December Group 2: Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> December - Friday 19<sup>th</sup> December

Group 1 pupils will be leaving school after lunch and will return at around 5pm on Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> December. Group 2 will leave at 12:30pm on Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> December and will return at around 2:30pm on Friday 19<sup>th</sup> December.

Due to timings, and possibly traffic, arrangements will need to be made by parents/carers for your child's safe journey home. The school buses will not be available on Friday 19<sup>th</sup> December when the coach returns at 2.30pm due to school closing at 12pm that day.

We are kindly requesting a voluntary contribution of £86 per pupil. This contribution will go towards the cost of the event and travel, all meals are included at Castlerigg. If we are unable to raise enough funds this may result in the trip being cancelled.

If your child accesses Pupil Premium funding, this trip will be subsidised. You will see the reduced cost when you access Scopay.
