3D Design	Model/Prototype production. Pupils will think about their design ideas and try making a model of them using household waste cardboard. Once their model is finished they should take pictures of it from different angles and print them out if needed to add any changes they feel need to be made for it to work/function better. There are 3 stages to the work/challenge and it is scheduled to become active on Teams on Friday 17th July.	Hard copies to be given out in class before the end of July. Construction	Complete the booklet – drawings of different types of foundations, revise and test yourself so that you are confident that you can draw the 4 different types and explain how they are constructed (strip / trench fill / pad and pile / raft)	This work links to the design task that students will sit in November which is worth 30% of their final grade for Construction.
